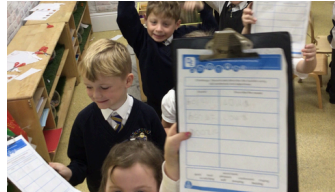

Black Nike rucksack with a water bottle in the side, lost on the park on Wednesday morning. Please return to the school office if found. Thank you.

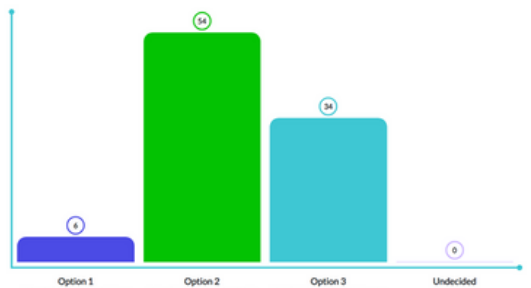
Junior Leadership Team News

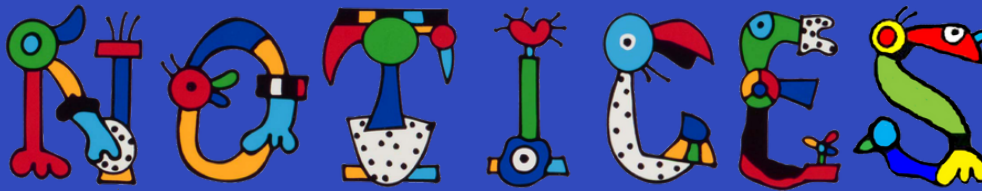

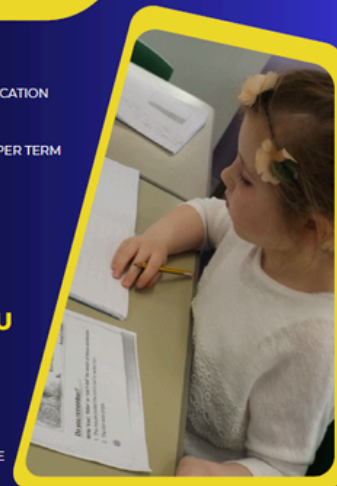
